The Inghirami Family is renowned in Italy for their textiles and fashion and have been the custodians of Fattoria di Grignano in Chianti Rufina for over 50 years. The Estate was once the personal property of Catherine di Medici and today is planted with vineyards and olive orchards that are certified organically farmed.

Tommaso Inghirami is the third generation of the family to be involved with the Grignano Estate and today is championing a new identity for the wines of Rufina. Rufina, located high in the hills just east of Florence, produces wines with pronounced acidity and freshness, with a long-standing reputation for aging beautifully for 25 years or more. Tommaso grew up in Sansepolcro in rural Tuscany and now lives near the winery in Florence. He attended San Diego State University and Bocconi University in Milan before working in China for Montcler clothing and Piedmont Italy for Ferrero Rocher Chocolate. In addition to leading the evolution of Grignano and Pietramaggio, Tommaso also co-founded Truffle Italia, exporting fresh truffles around the world each fall.
