4-7 inches of rain per year



Irrigation from Andean  
snowmelt only

and reservoirs at Rupestre  
vineyard. No electricity.



### RUPESTRE VINEYARD

**Elevation** 7,545 ft

**Soil** Clay and sandy soil with  
mineral deposits but few stones

**Climate** Well insulated and slightly  
cooler

**Varietals** Cabernet, Malbec, Tannat

**Wine Effects** High acidity, spicy, pepper  
flavors



### YACOCUYA VINEYARD

**Elevation** 6,560 ft

**Soil** Sandy and rocky soil

**Climate** Sunny with altitude effect

**Varietals** Cabernet, Malbec

**Wine Effects** Fruit-driven flavors



### CAFAYATE VINEYARD

**Elevation** 5,575 ft

**Soil** Sandy soil

**Climate** Strong sun in the valley

**Varietals** Torrontés

**Wine Effects** Good maturity and freshness
