Boya, the family's second label, has all the attributes that have come to be associated with sauvignon blanc from the region: It's citric and firm, with a firm texture and lovely herbal and especially fruity notes. The aromas and flavors are influenced by the sea breezes from the Pacific, the austere texture by the granitic soils of the coastal hills. A surprisingly fresh and vibrant 2015."
