




- J. Bouchon is a 4th generation, family-owned winery based in Chile's southern Maule Valley.
- The winemaking team has focused on extensive soil research in their vineyards to bring quality and sense of place to their wines that is unique to Maule.



PAÍS FAST FACTS

- First vinifera vine ever brought to the Americas from the Canary Islands, Spain in the 1500's.
- Vigorous, productive, and tolerant of drought.
- Many vines in Chile are over 100 years old.
- Mostly planted in the Maule Valley.

TASTING NOTES:

Light, juicy red fruits, firm tannins, medium acidity.
