WINERY BACKGROUND: Bodini is crafted by winemaker Jimena Lopez and showcases fruit grown by a small estate winery in Mendoza, Argentina. Leaving her corporate wine job to pursue her dream of making her own wine highlights Jimena's tenacious drive that has helped her become the incredible winemaker she is today. Jimena has made wine for 19 years in 7 countries, and besides Bodini, she also owns her own boutique winery, Graffito, that boasts consistently high accolades and has a track record of 90 point scores. Jimena is a passionate, dedicated winemaker with an unmatched attention to detail.

Bodini wines are fresh, fruit-forward, and showcase grapes with the fullest expression of the Mendoza region.

WINEMAKING DETAILS: A high-elevation desert, Mendoza has long sunny days, cold nights, low humidity, and natural irrigation from glacial snowmelt from the Andes Mountains. The deep soil is a sandy-clay texture with the presence of large boulders originally from the Mendoza River thousands of years ago.

TASTING NOTES & FOOD PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: Layered fresh fruit aromas on the nose. Black cherry, plum and black pepper on the palate. A broad wine with an elegant finish. Bodini showcases Mendoza's high-altitude mountain terroir for the fullest expression of fresh fruit flavors.

Pair with roasted chicken, glazed short ribs, burgers, shredded beef tacos or grilled peppers.
