Hailing from the iconic Lewelling family's ranch, Dave and Doug grew up on the farm and continue the family's tradition of winemaking. Their vineyards sit on estate Napa land that was first planted in 1864 and is the longest continuously farmed land in the Napa Valley.

Each has his own hand in the business. Doug attended Cal Poly and then worked at Martini Winery from 1973-1977. He now manages the Lewelling vineyards as well as 500 additional acres in Napa. Dave studied philosophy at Harvard, worked at Inglenook Winery in Napa, earned a degree in viticulture from UC Davis, and is now the head winemaker for Lewelling. Dave's daughter, Haley Wight, also helps make the Lewelling wines in addition to her own label, Hayfork.
