After graduating from the University of Chile with a Master's Degree in Enology and Viticulture, Christian took his first wine job in New Zealand (Felton Road) where he was able to work in Biodynamic agriculture. In 2009 he worked in Burgundy at the Comte Armand winery, where he was able to make wine (Pinot Noir and Chardonnay) from more than 30 different appellations from Village to the most outstanding Grand Cru. Since then he has traveled extensively to different wine regions of the world, including Australia, Portugal and Spain.



After working abroad, Christian returned to Chile to join Viña Tabali (Limari Valley, Chile) in 2011 as their winemaker. He went on to create their award-winning Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir, and Syrah from the desert north. In 2016 Christian headed south to the Maule Valley to take the position of Chief Winemaker for J. Bouchon --- where he loves working with the historical roots of both the Bouchon family and the southern, ancestral terroir of Maule.

For Christian, it is essential to travel and know the different wines and wine regions of the world to always keep expanding his education and never stop innovating.
